


- SF12 INDIA & WORLD WAR II (1939-1945): Netaji quits Congress, Forms Indian National Army.
- SF13 QUIT INDIA MOVEMENT (1942-1945): People Movement started. Gandhiji interned in Aga Khan's Palace.
- SF14 MUSLIM LEAGUE & PARTITION (1905-1947): Growth of communalism. League decided to wreck the Govt. from within.
- SF15 INDIA ACHIEVES INDEPENDENCE (1945-1947): India divided into two independent dominions India and Pakistan, National Flag hoisted on Red Fort on 15th August, 1947.
